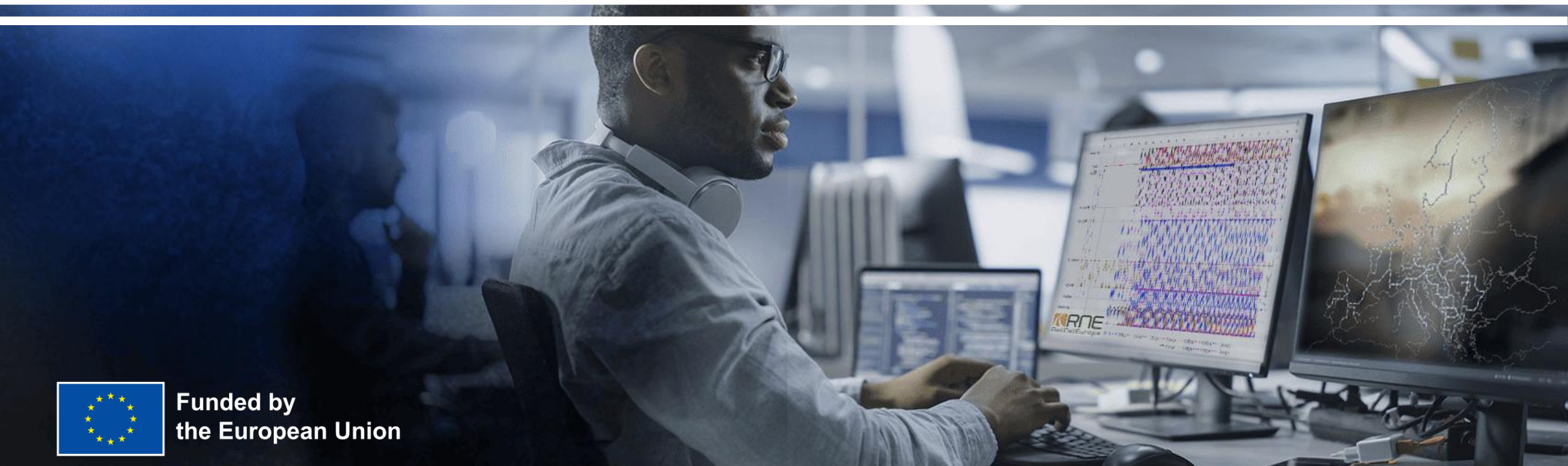

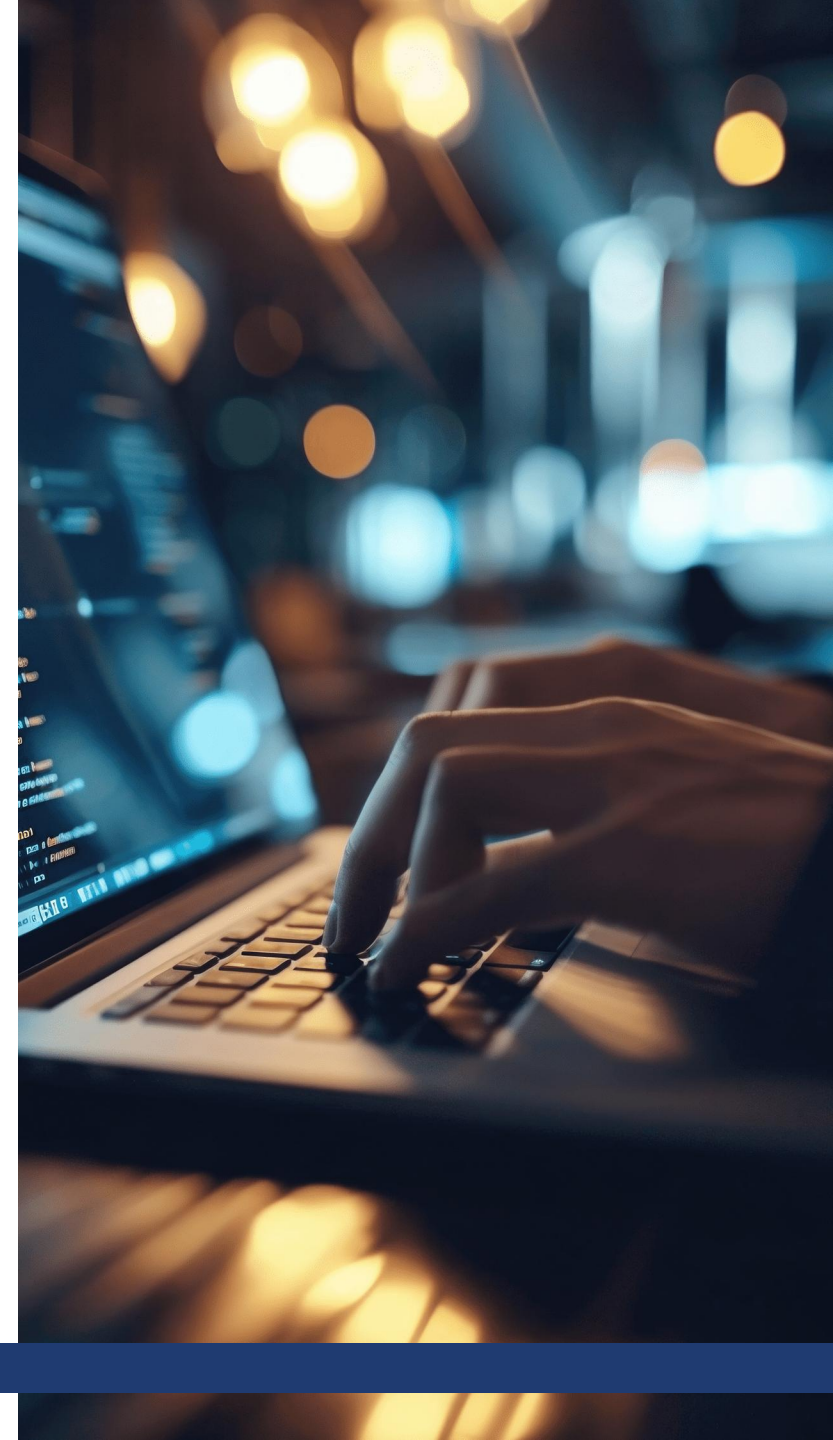

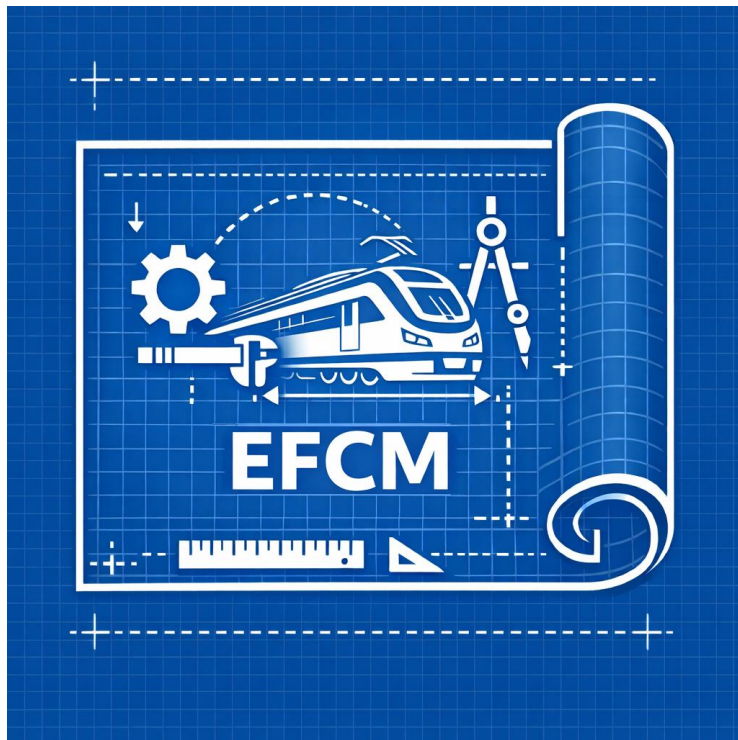

- Which contents to include?

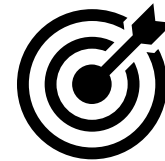

- Defines **chapters** and **sub-topics**

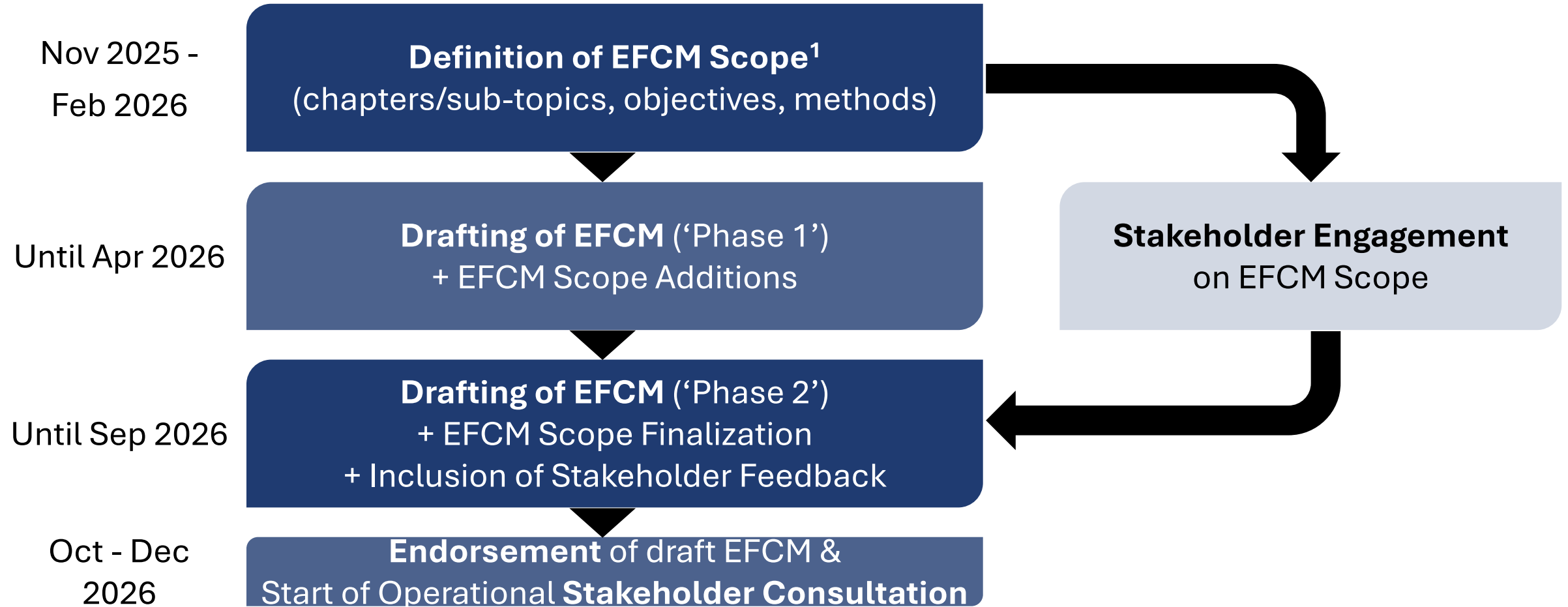


- Describes the **objectives** for each **sub-topic**



- Explains the **methods** to achieve these **objectives**

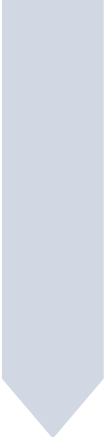
EFCM Drafting Timeline

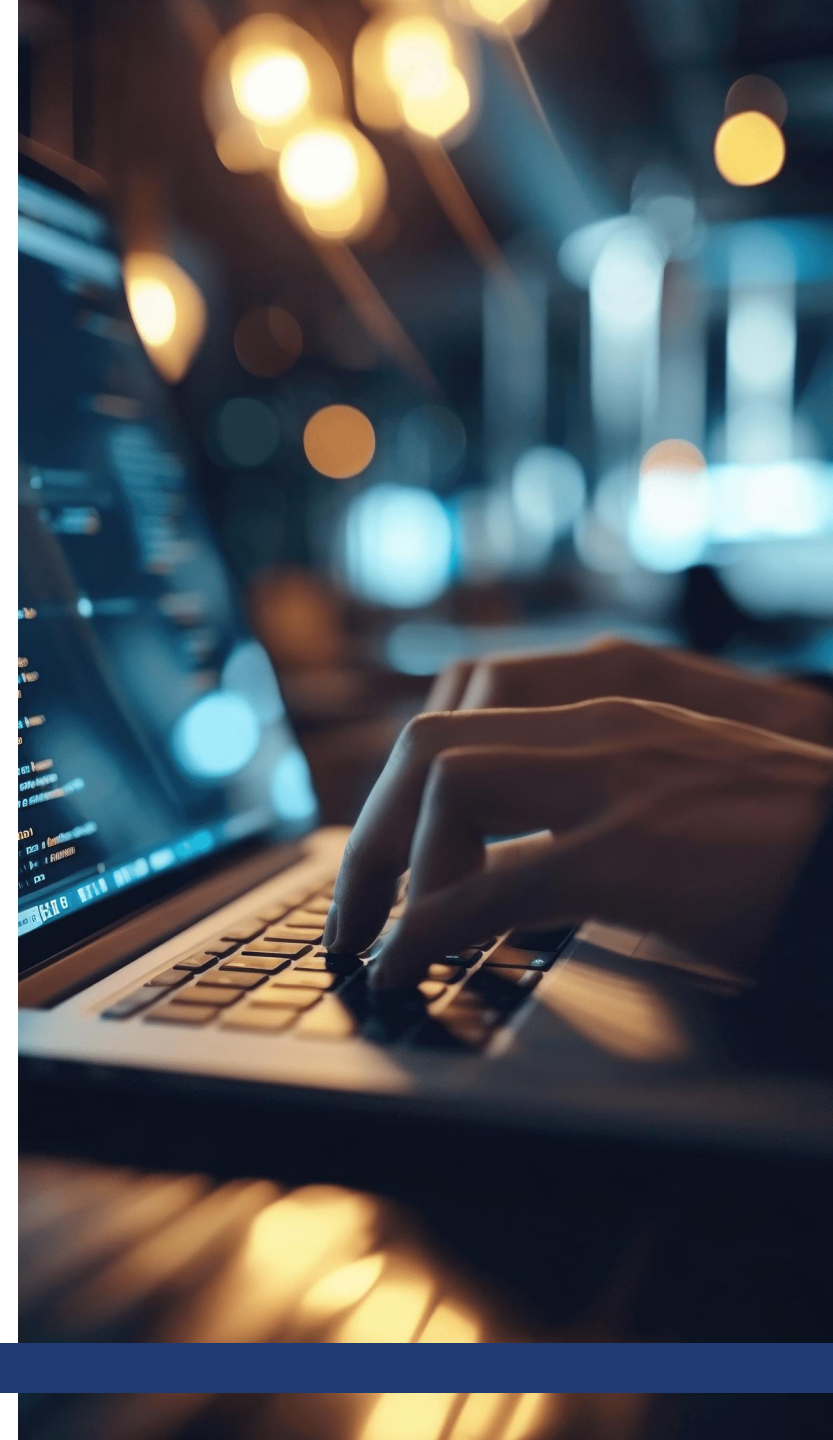

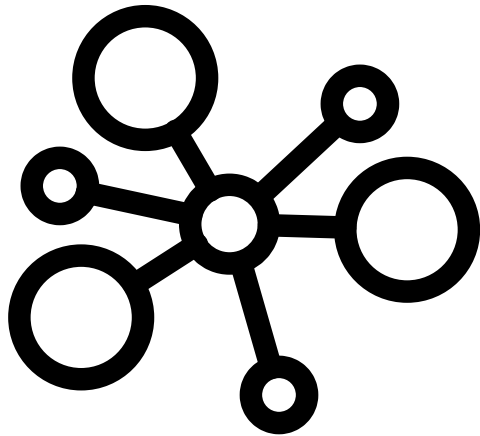

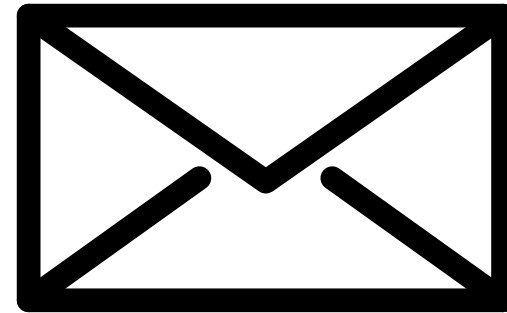
02 Overview of the submitted feedback

Status: June 2026



- **Considered → Reflects the ongoing discussions**

~ 70%



- **To DO → Open points to be still discussed within the relevant groups**

~ 20%



- **Different opinions (IM-RU) → To be further discussed within relevant groups**

~ 10%

Allocation of Capacity Rights (incl. changes and ad hoc)

example

Considered



- **Tailor-made requests** remain possible
- **Multi-network coordination & deadlines**
- **Early involvement of Applicants in the alteration** (preliminary phase)
- Only **one business process** for requesting ad hoc capacity rights
- Fully standardised **conversion** of capacity specification
- **Quality requirement** for **conversion** of capacity specifications
- **Technical check** of the requests of capacity rights for military – defence purposes
- **Alteration / Modification** (including the classification of change types)

- **Staffed one-stop shop**
- **Commercial Conditions**

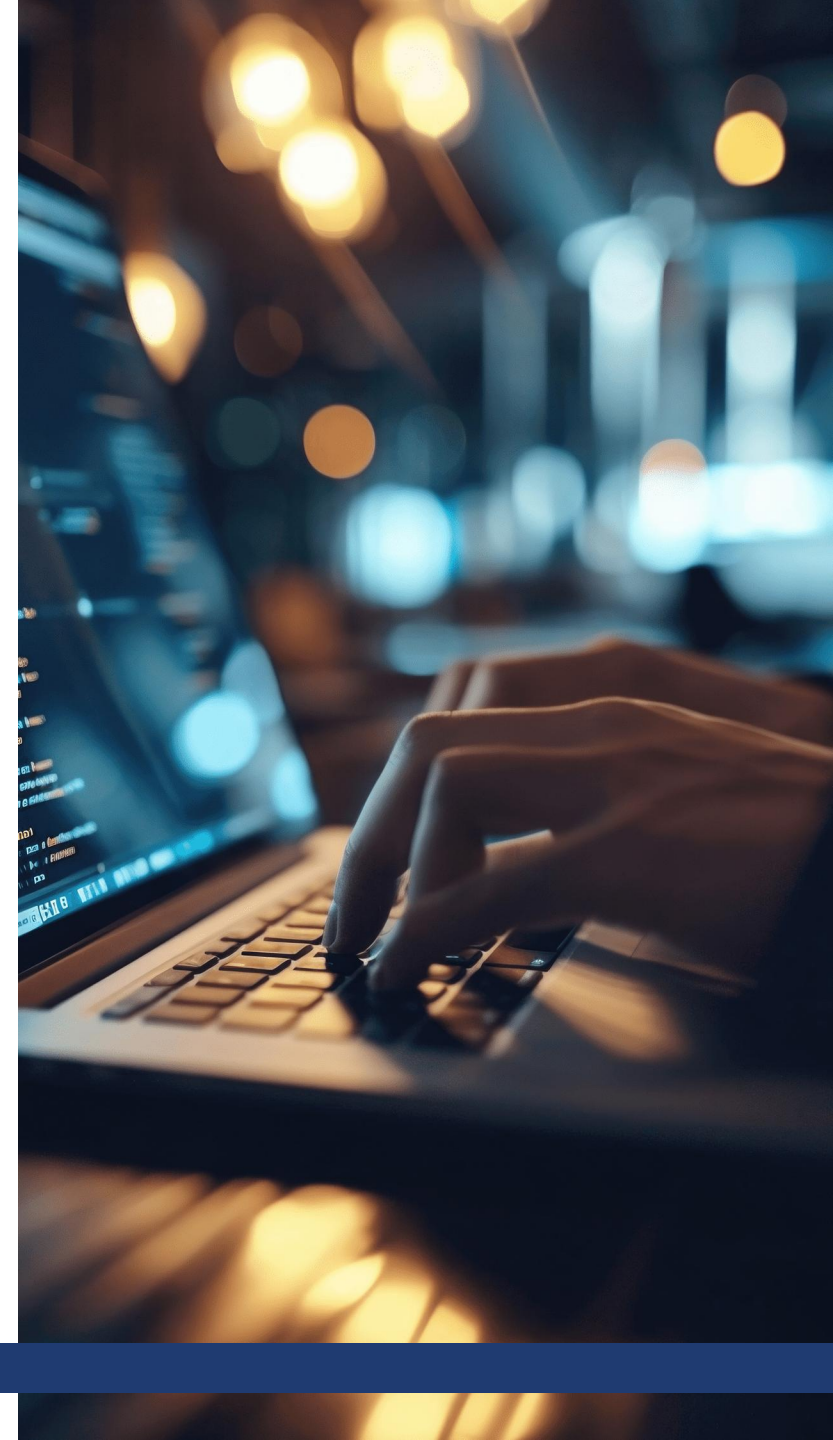
