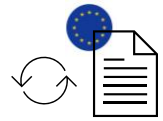
The Proposal for ERP Has Been Submitted

Proposal for ERP submitted to the European Commission with broad support from operational stakeholder associations.

- > The proposal was endorsed by the FTE Plenary Assembly and ERP partners and supporters.
- > **Submission made on 11 June 2026**, same day the Capacity Regulation entered into force.
- > ERP will be open to all!

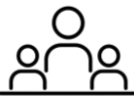

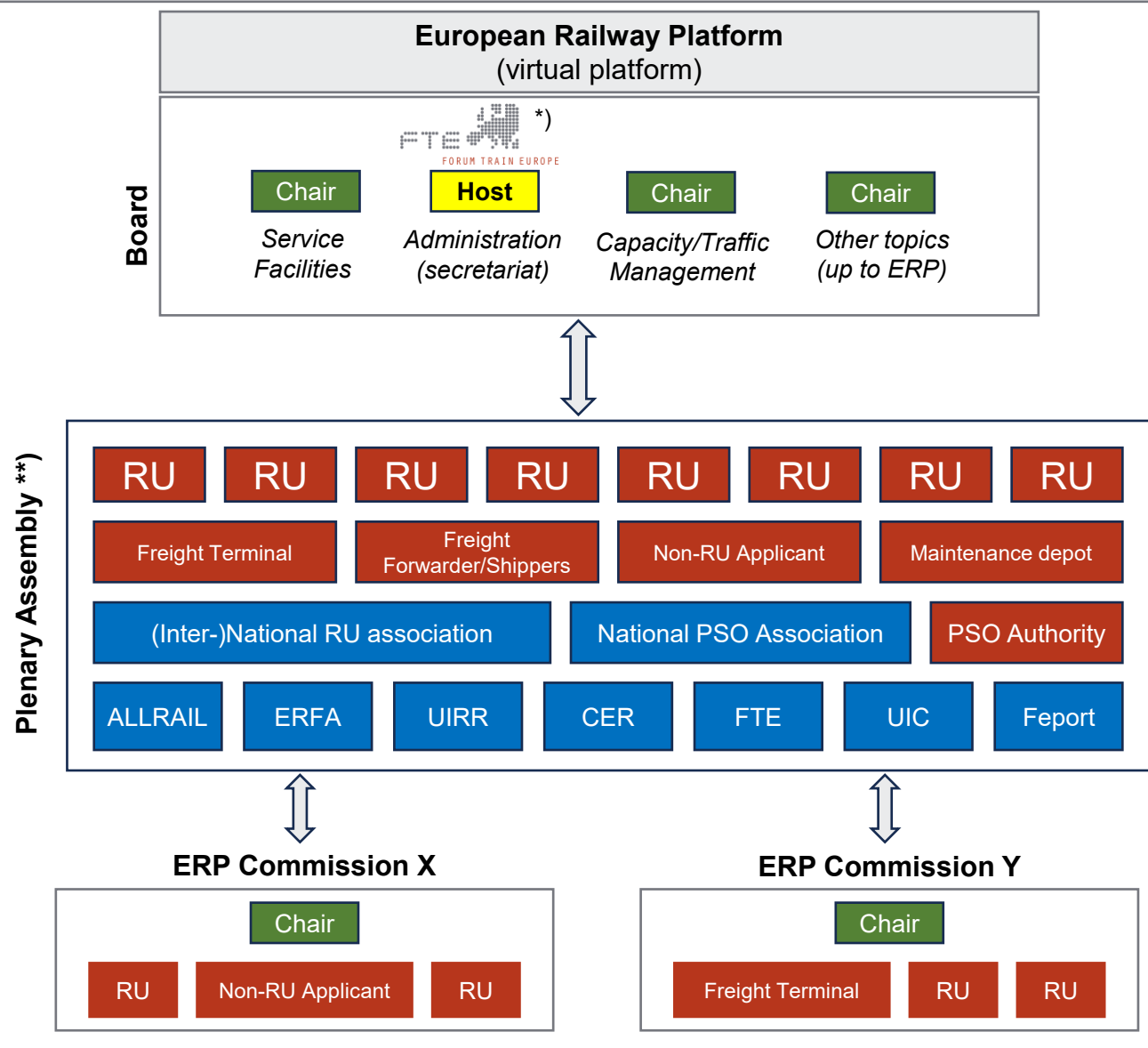

Reminder: Schematic View of ERP Structure

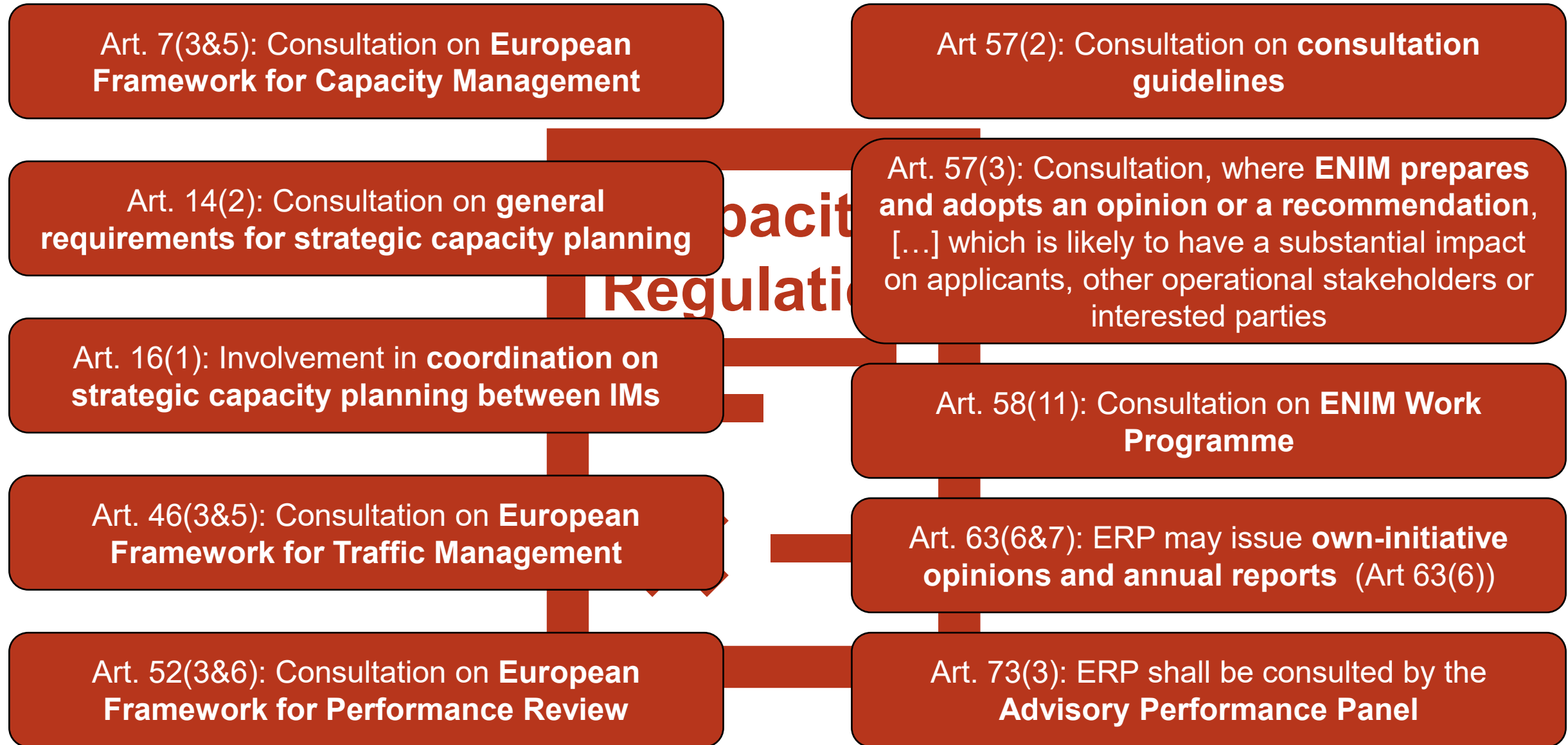


- > **Board:** operational body of ERP
- > **Host:** in charge of administration
- > **Chairs:** organisations in charge of a topic: analyse, prepare, moderate for ERP, and facilitate the results
- > **Proposed Candidates:**
 - FTE: Host (Secretariat) and chair for Capacity and Traffic Management
 - UIRR: Chair for Service Facilities

- > **Plenary:** decision-making body meeting online
- > Adopts ERP positions towards other stakeholders (mainly ENIM / ENRRB)
- > Elects the chairs and the host
- > Members without voting rights: 

- > **Commissions:** flexible bodies for dialogues on the complex agenda points of the ERP Plenary
