- 4. The importance of PLCs, SLCs and UIC-codes

- Primary Location code (PLC): A unique code that identifies a service facility worldwide. See list for NAEs* and NCPs**; e.g., AT01956
- Subsidiary Location Code (SLC): Allows to substructure a Primary Location and to define closer what can be done there; can be defined by each service facility, e.g., BTT1012345
- **UIC-Code (RICS)**: A unique code to identify a railway-oriented organization. See https://uic.org/support-activities/it/rics; e.g., 0006
- PLCs, SLCs and UICs are essential for automated computing of railway data and for the interaction between IT-systems.







5. How to use the Excel sheet for data up- and download

- Live demo of
 - the <u>Excel sheet with explanations</u> (do not use for upload)
 - the <u>Excel sheet without explanations</u> (use for upload)
- For new facilities, leave the column "id" in the sheet empty. A new identifier, unique to the system will be attributed.
- For existing facilities, first download your data and use the attributed id for the changes of your data, otherwise duplicate facilities can occur.







- 6. How to up- and download data via an interface

- RNE will provide a standard interface for automatized computer-2-computerdata exchange. If you are willing to connect, contact us and we will help you define the data mapping.
- A C2C-data exchange enables you to perform real-time updates e.g., for capacity planning (legally mandatory).
