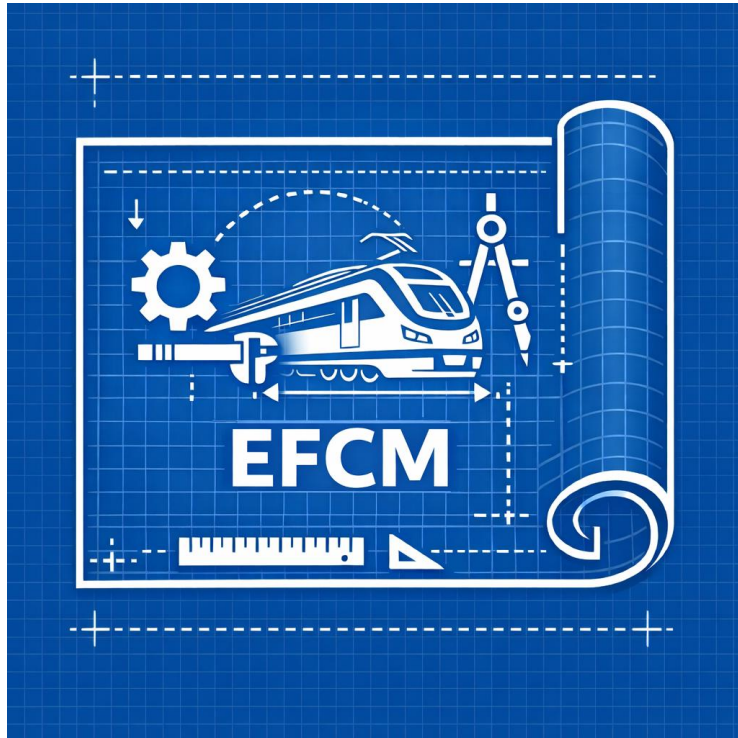

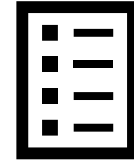

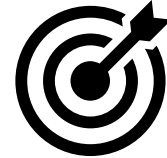

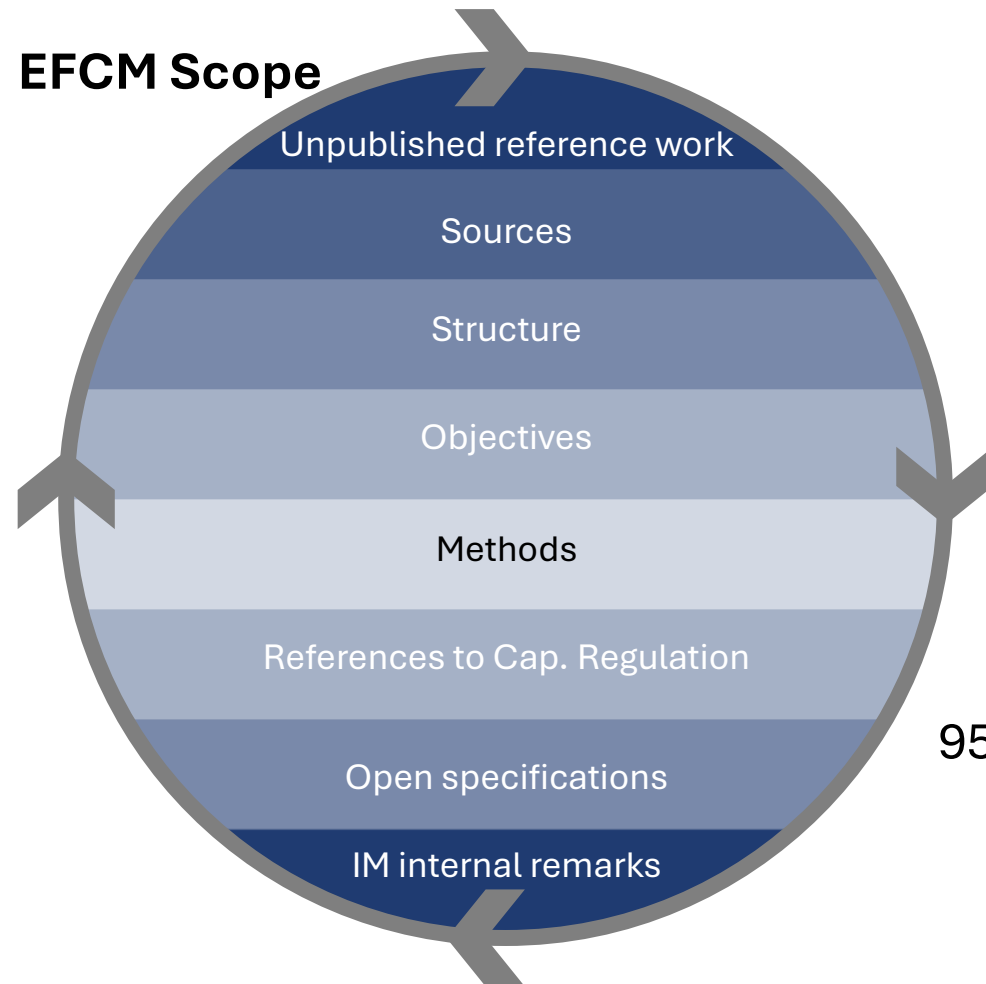

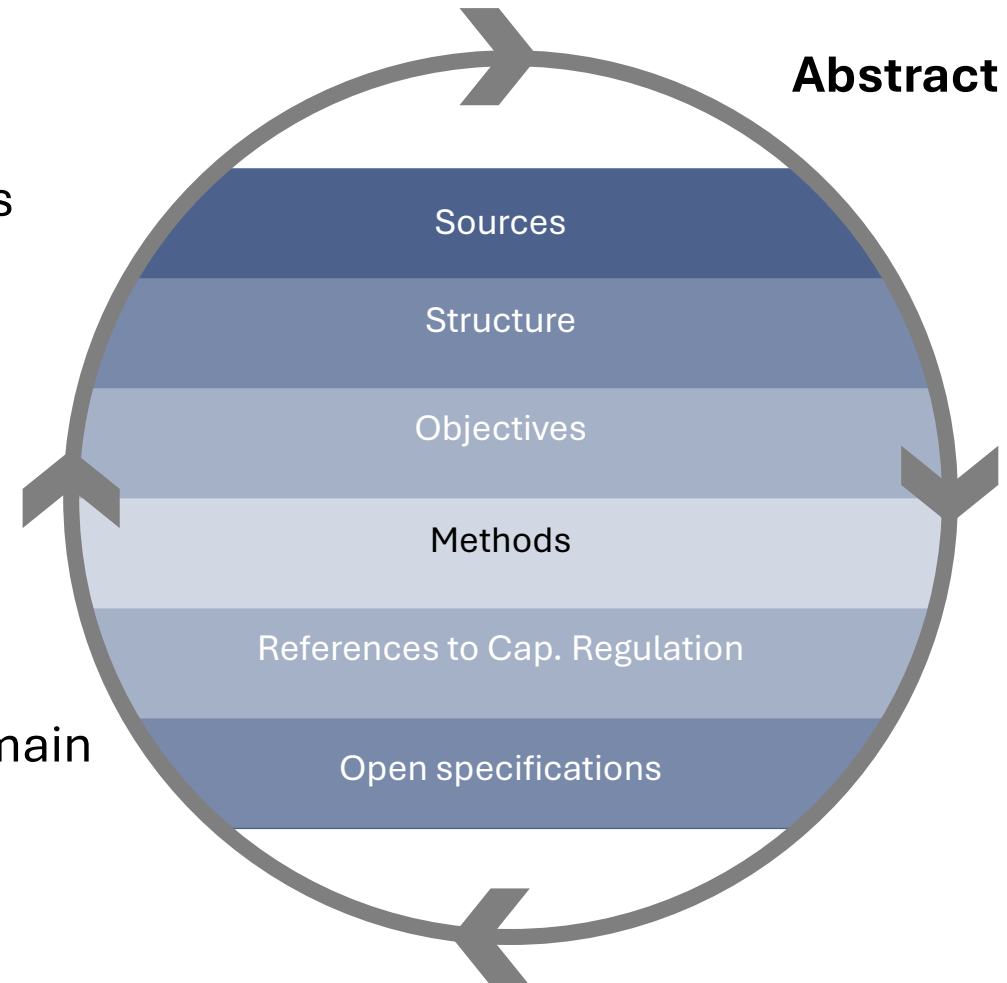

Abstract

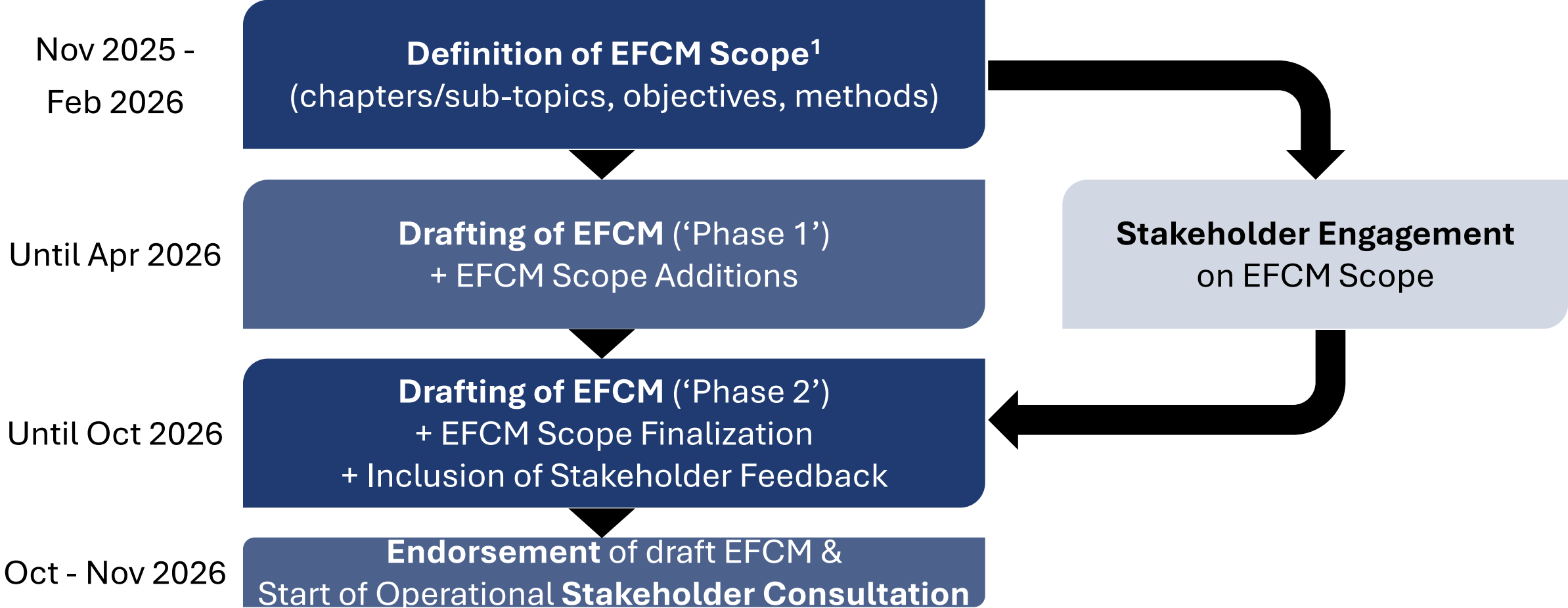


95% of the EFCM remain in the Abstract

 - Are the mechanisms **practical** (incl. resource perspective)?
 - Are **preconditions** well described and met?
