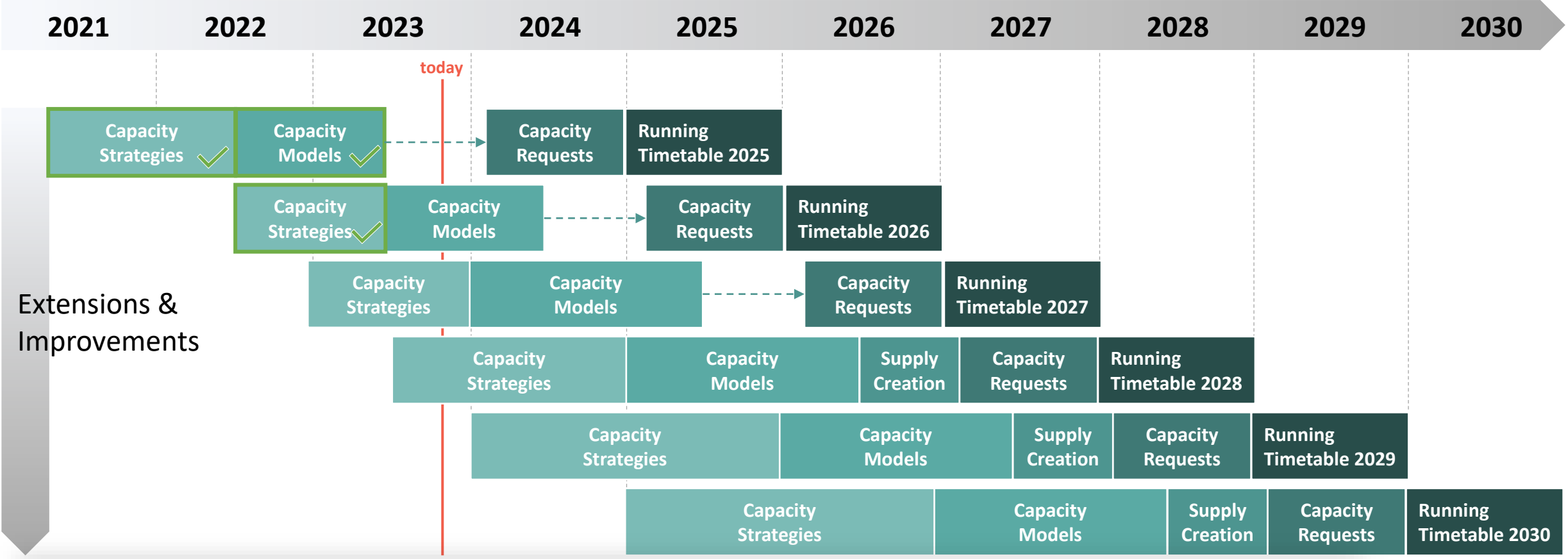

for cooperation between all stakeholders established, regular exchange among national projects and RNE JO ensured



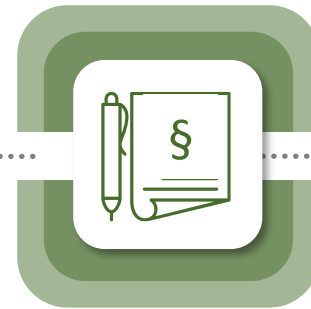
## First TTR components rolled out

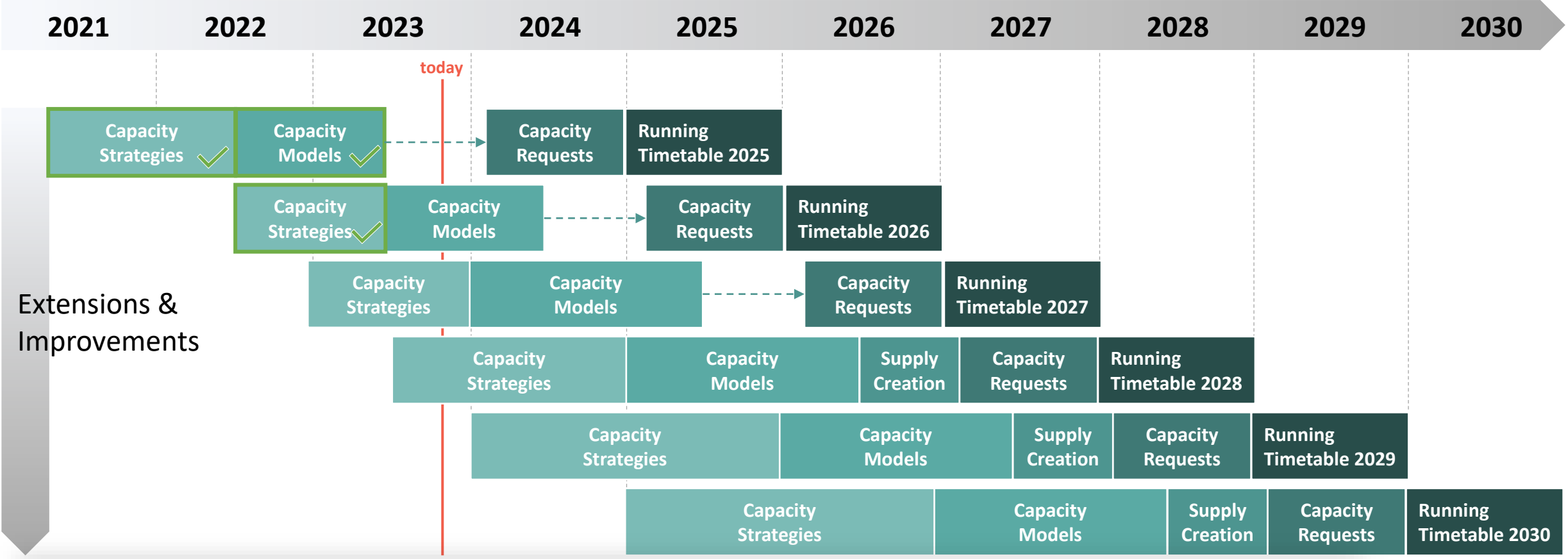
# TTR – from idea to reality



## Gradual implementation principles:

- **Follow the process timeline:**  
Implement one TTR component after another
- **Increase the geographical scope:**  
Start with first-wave implementers' main lines and extend with each timetable period the lines and partaking IMs
- **Facilitate improvements:**  
Learn from each implementation step and use findings to improve the processes, IT systems and deliverables in the next timetable period

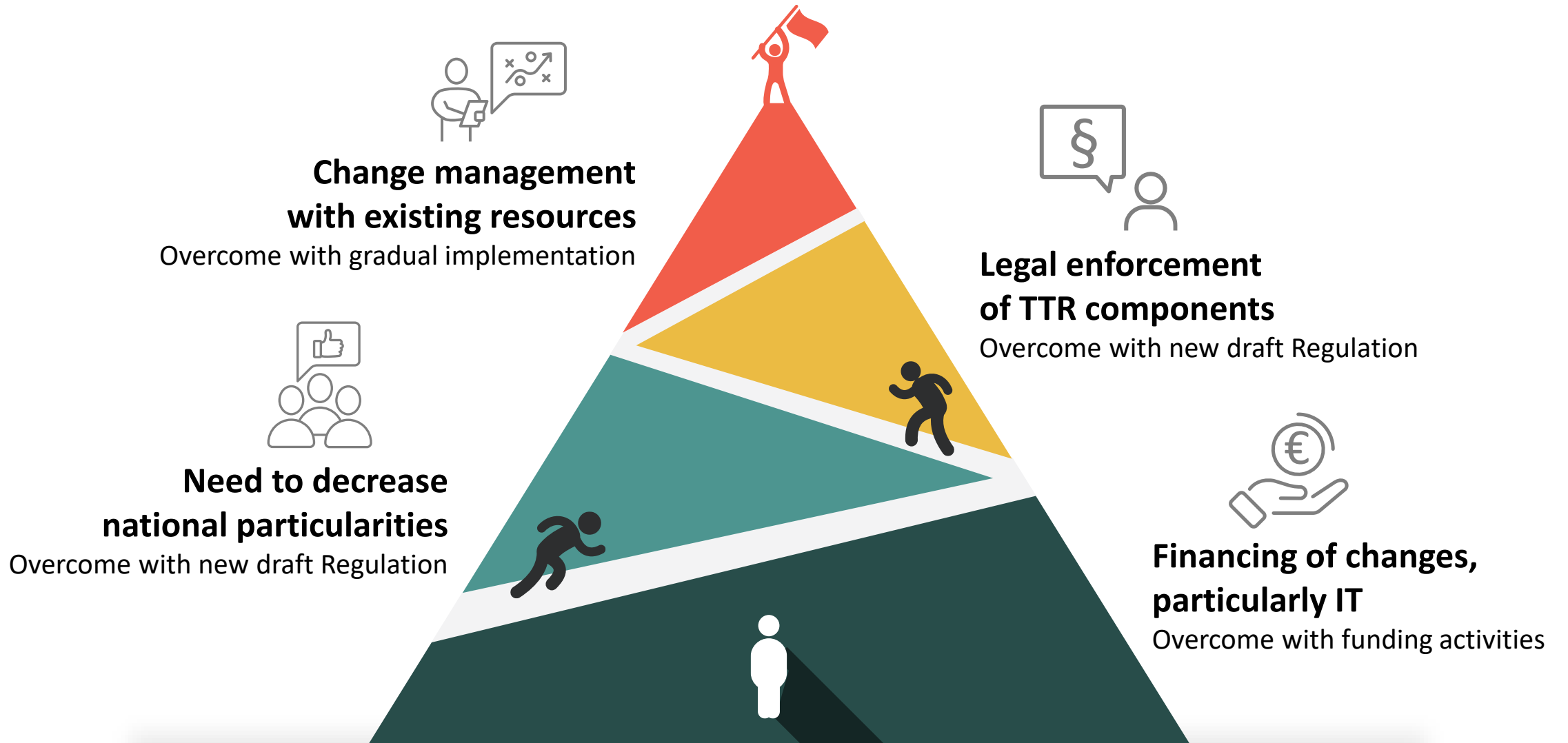

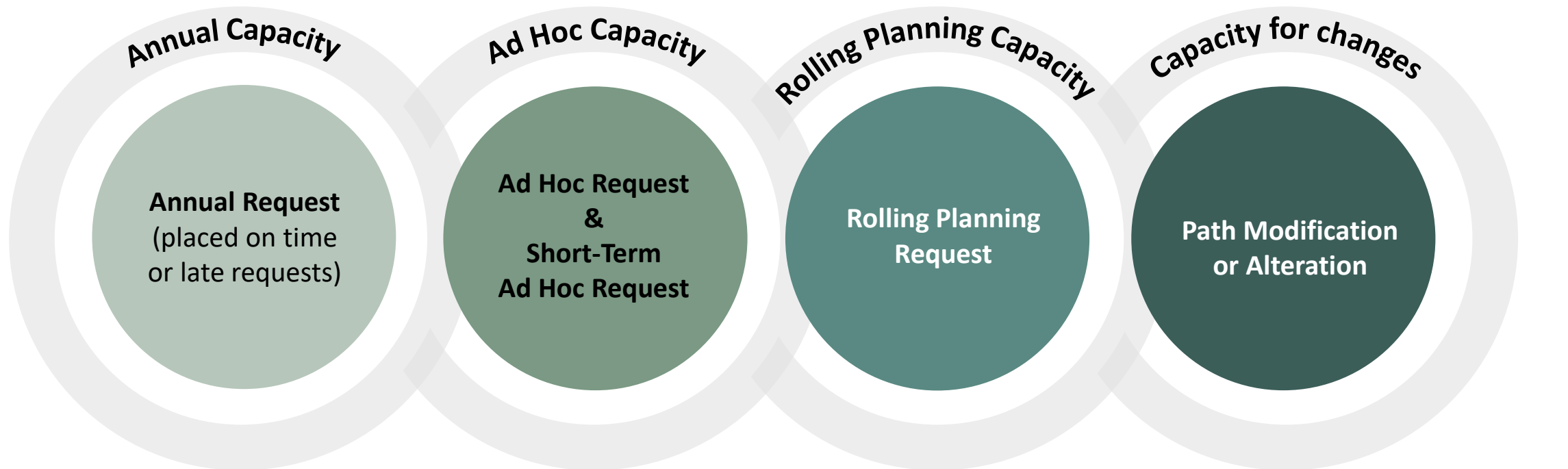

- **European Framework for capacity management to be adopted**

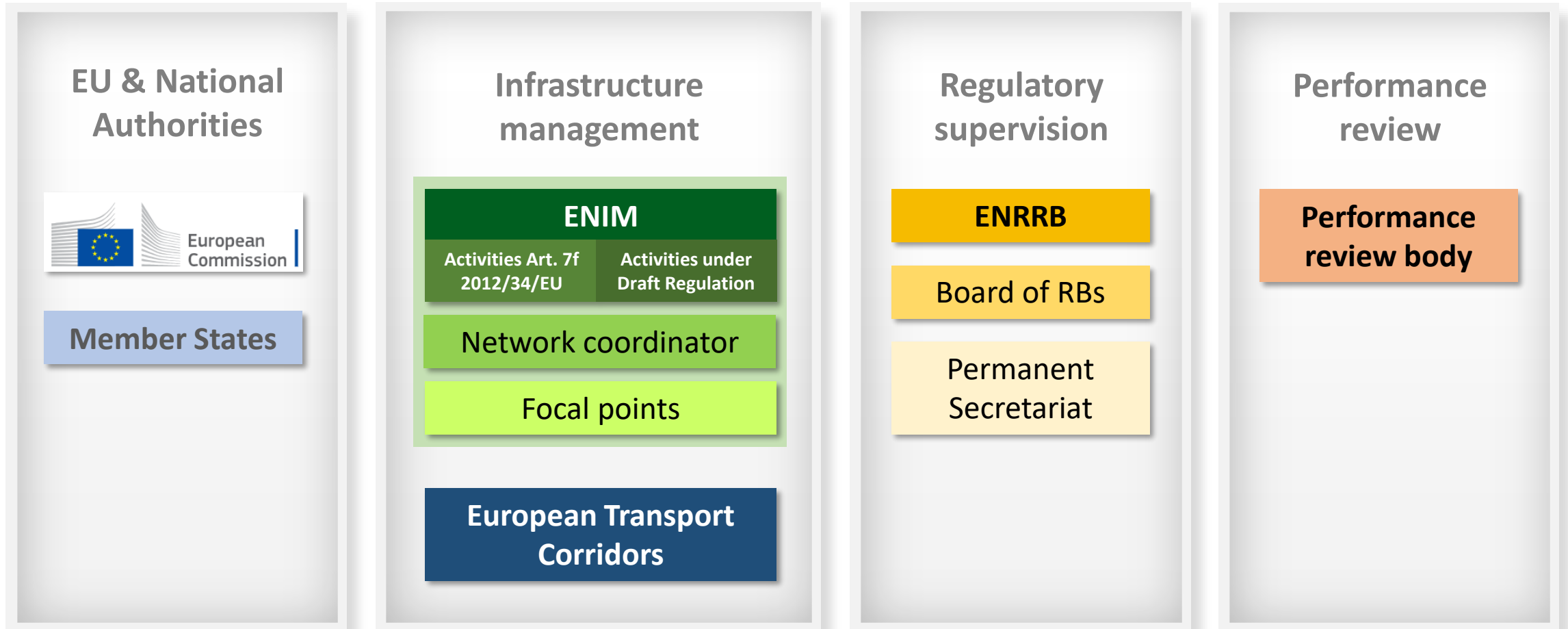
## Traffic Management

- Inspired by ETMN concept and ICM Handbook
- **European Framework for coordination of cross-border traffic, disruption and crisis management to be adopted**

## Performance review

- Covering infrastructure, CM, TM, disruption/crisis mgmt., digital tools, compliance
- New independent performance review body
- **European Framework for Performance review to be adopted**
