





### TTR Commercial Conditions project

Geographical Scope (original)

IMs involved in the TTR project worked on the elaboration of harmonised Commercial Conditions Guidelines, aiming to provide a **feasible** and <u>Europe-wide</u> **applicable solution** to support the TTR implementation

Steer, but not punish




Support new Capacity Management process





### New regulatory framework for Commercial Conditions



Art. 40 – Compensation/Penalty for changes to capacity rights

- ENIM to define a harmonised framework for Commercial Conditions
- Incentive schemes are part of European framework for capacity management
- Incentive system consider major changes in capacity rights already allocated (art. 39);
- Incentives defined at national level after Applicants consultation and Regulatory Body's approval;




### Main components of the RNE Guidelines






## 3 Consultation process






### Key aspects of consultation process



- Information and participation to all the **stakeholders** (Applicants + Associations + Institutions)
- **Testing of new approaches** of stakeholders' consultation process
- **Communication** with website news, LinkedIn, workshop
- Use online **MS Form** to collect inputs with simple registration
- Duration: **60 days** 
  - Report on inputs received to be published with the final document
- **Dedicated mailbox** for any support and additional input\request


